Lincoln Park Zoo Announces Line-Up for Annual Summer Concert Series

Chicago (June 2, 2010) — Prepare to dance the night away with Lincoln Park Zoo as they kick off their annual outdoor summer concert series *Jammin' at the Zoo* this June. Presenting one show per month all summer long, this wild experience offers family fun for all ages. Located on the zoo's South Lawn this year's hot line-up will feature **Lifhouse** with **Michael Franti (June 25)**, **Collective Soul** with **The Lovehammers (July 23)** and **Guster (August 27)**. Tickets are on sale starting June 4.

In the heart of the zoo surrounded by big trees, mischievous gibbons and elegant flamingos, Lincoln Park Zoo's South Lawn provides the perfect environment for this unique Chicago summer music fest. Come early to grab a bite at Park Place Café serving a variety of food and drinks. Beer and wine will also be available for purchase to those 21 years and older.

Gates open to ticket holders at 6 pm (zoo members with tickets can enter 15 minutes early to stake out premium seating). The South Lawn provides spacious open seating and guests are encouraged to bring a small blanket for comfort, but please leave coolers, outside food and drinks behind as they are not permitted into the event. Grab your tickets early because all performances typically sell out quickly! Individual performance tickets are available as well as discounted rates for purchasing the entire series.

Avoid the service fee by purchasing tickets in person at the zoo's Gateway Pavilion beginning June 4. Advance tickets are \$23 with discounts available for children and Lincoln Park Zoo Members. Zoo membership dues range from \$50-\$120 annually and come with numerous special benefits including invitations to exclusive member-only events, discounts on parking and special event tickets such as *Jammin' at the Zoo*.
