Visiting Lincoln Park Zoo for ZooLights






I will need to wear my mask to stay safe and healthy. If I need a mask break, I can take it off when I am outside.

I will notice many people wearing a mask. People wearing a green uniform work at the zoo and want to help me. I can still see their


eyes.

I can visit the animals at the zoo. Some animals I want to visit may not be out because it is nighttime. That is okay. I know they are safe.






Some of the buildings with animals inside will be closed, but there are still lots of places I can go to visit animals.
