

Achieving With Your Support

In Lincoln Park Zoo's 157-year history, a few milestones stand above the rest. Thirty years ago, in 1995, we privatized operations under The Lincoln Park Zoological Society, launching a new era of impact in conservation, animal wellbeing, advocacy, and public education. Back then, we were a small Chicago zoo with a bold vision for better animal welfare, a stronger city presence, and global leadership in wildlife conservation. We knew we would need our community's support—and you responded.

Your generosity over the past three decades has transformed Lincoln Park Zoo into a global leader. Today, we employ more than 40 scientists advancing conservation, animal wellbeing, and population biology, partnering with organizations to save species and wild spaces in 30 countries. Our guest experience makes us the most visited and inclusive cultural organization in Chicago, and our expertise in animal welfare is sought after by partners and policymakers around the world.

With your support, here's what we've accomplished—both over 30 years and in the past year:

- Animal Welfare Science Program: Now the largest of its kind in the nation, this program is fueled by ZooMonitor, a Lincoln Park Zoo app and invention used by 1,000+ animal institutions worldwide as of the end of 2024. Our science-driven approach ensures the best possible lives for animals in our care.
- **Project ChimpCARE:** We created the authoritative database on all chimpanzees in the U.S., establishing our leadership in primatology. In 2024, we led a coalition of 115+ institutions to advocate for the Captive Primate Safety Act, now advancing through Congress.
- **African Lion Conservation:** Our partnership in Tanzania to protect lion migratory corridors is paying off—this year, we celebrated the return of male lions to the Ngorongoro Crater in numbers not seen in decades.
- Alexander Center for Applied Population Biology: Our scientists have developed tools for wildlife reintroduction, including efforts to help save the Puerto Rican parrot. In 2024, the Alexander Center expanded its impact, protecting red wolves, Hungarian meadow vipers, Hawaiian honeycreepers, and Attwater's prairie chickens.
- **Population Management Center:** As the Association of Zoos and Aquariums' "match.com for animals," we make breeding recommendations and lead Species Survival Plans® to responsibly sustain zoo populations. This year, SSPs brought a meerkat mob, a pair of emperor tamarins, and fan-favorite red wolf Poco to Lincoln Park Zoo.
- **Urban Wildlife Institute and Urban Wildlife Information Network:** Together, UWI and UWIN set best practices for city wildlife coexistence and host the world's largest database on urban species. In 2024, we welcomed our 60th city to the network.

Amid all this, we remain committed to Chicago—free to all, every day. The vision that guided privatization in 1995 asked: What could we achieve together? Your support has answered that question beyond our highest hopes. Thank you for shaping the zoo of the future—one that serves wildlife, nature, and people in Chicago and around the world. We can't wait to see what we accomplish together next.






Three Decades of ZooLights

The dazzle of millions of lights, the glow of rainbow-striped zebras, the hum of carolers, the buzzing of an ice sculpture forming, the warmth of hot chocolate, the embrace from loved ones, the little ones falling asleep on the car ride home with a new plush tucked under their arms...there is nothing quite like ZooLights.

Since 1994, a team of hundreds has transformed the zoo into a wonderland every winter, welcoming families from Chicago and beyond. There have been many constants during the event's tenure, including famous displays like the giant snowman and the long-standing support and sponsorship of ComEd since the very first ZooLights.


Each year also brings new delights—from 3D glasses to thematic shows and interactive light walls. Since 2021, ZooLights has used 100% energy-saving LED lights and is powered by green, renewable wind energy. Today, with your support, the event provides more than \$1.5 million annually to help keep the zoo free and open to all, 365 days a year.

Stewards for Animals

Lincoln Park Zoo has long advocated for animals, and this past year was no exception. The zoo is using decades of scientific research to advance legislation that will benefit wildlife and wild places.

THE CAPTIVE PRIMATE **SAFETY ACT**

Lincoln Park Zoo has been a leader in a national effort to urge the passage of the Captive Primate Safety Act, which would end the private ownership of primates as pets in the U.S. While the CPSA was originally introduced in 2005, the 2024 HBO Max documentary Chimp Crazy created an opportunity to build greater public support and momentum for the bill.

Lincoln Park Zoo led the charge within the Association of Zoos and Aquariums community and rallied more than 116 wildlife organizations to endorse the bill's passage. The zoo secured two features in The New York Times sharing the story of Eli and Susie, chimpanzees rescued by the zoo from the entertainment industry. Since 2020, they have resided in a private habitat with their own chimp troop behind the scenes at Lincoln Park Zoo. The zoo's efforts helped increase congressional sponsors of the bill from 22 to 55. In 2025, the CPSA was reintroduced in the new Congress and is one step closer to becoming law.

PRIMATES IN THE PRESS

Due to his background as a pet and performer and lack of appropriate socialization prior to his arrival at the zoo, chimpanzee Eli often needs reassurance. A clip of troopmate Magadi comforting him with a hug amassed more than 8.3 million views on the zoo's Instagram.

"The zoo's task is a deeply paradoxical one, with humans responsible for erasing years of human influence. Helping the animals heal often means keeping them at a distance and ignoring their entreaties. It means declining Susie's requests for conflict mediation and refusing to engage when Zachary blows kisses. As Ms. Leahy put it: 'That push and pull between what they understand a relationship with a human being is and us wanting to encourage them to become chimpanzees again—or for the first time, in some sense—means sort of systematically pulling away from our relationship with them."

PROTECTING THE ENDANGERED SPECIES ACT

In early 2025, the federal administration proposed changing the definition of "harm" in the Endangered Species Act to remove habitat modifications. The change would unravel decades of progress, accelerate biodiversity collapse, and strip future generations of the wild places and wildlife we all cherish.

Chicago-area nature advocates, including Lincoln Park Zoo, Shedd Aquarium, Brookfield Zoo Chicago, The Morton Arboretum, and Chicago Botanic Garden co-signed an op-ed in the *Chicago Tribune*, authored by Dr. Megan Ross, imploring the public to submit a comment to the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service opposing this definition change, which would impact more than 1,600 species.

Lincoln Park Zoo also engaged zoo visitors on grounds, distributed action alerts to its email audience, and armed zoo staff and volunteers with information about the impacts of the proposed change. Altogether, 357,682 comments were submitted to lawmakers.

ADDRESSING ILLEGAL WILDLIFE TRAFFICKING


Wildlife trafficking is decimating endangered species. This multibillion-dollar transnational criminal activity is ranked as the fourth most profitable behind only the drug trade, arms trade, and human trafficking. Wildlife trafficking undermines conservation efforts, fuels corruption, and destabilizes communities that depend on wildlife for ecotourism.

The United States is one of the largest consumers of wildlife and wild products. In the past 25 years, Lincoln Park Zoo has provided care to more than 300 illegally trafficked animals confiscated at O'Hare International Airport.

In 2025, Lincoln Park Zoo became a member of the Wildlife Confiscations Network, which aims to mitigate animal trafficking and supports law enforcement by providing a coordinated care system for seized wildlife. Lincoln Park Zoo also works with Monitor Conservation Research Society to provide data-backed impacts on wildlife populations. This helps inform stricter laws that protect species and lead to harsher punishments for wildlife traffickers.



The Importance of Wellbeing



The Association of Zoos and Aquariums defines animal wellbeing as "a state of being comfortable, healthy, or happy." Lincoln Park Zoo is a leader when it comes to applying and evaluating strategies that support animal happiness.

CHOICE AND CONTROL

Lincoln Park Zoo uses science to help animals thrive. Zoo researchers ask questions about the physical and social lives of animals—large and small, from mammals to reptiles—and provide them with choices that help caretakers address their needs and preferences. Offering options also gives the animals as much control as possible over their own environments. Zoo staff evaluate and then share knowledge and tools with peer institutions around the world, making the zoo a leader in researching and implementing practical strategies that support animal wellbeing.



MEASURING HAPPINESS

One way the zoo works to maximize animal wellbeing is through ZooMonitor, a Lincoln Park Zoo-created app that runs on smartphones and tablets and can be used by anyone with a bit of training. ZooMonitor helps researchers record animal behavior, like where animals spend time in their habitats and how often they are feeding and foraging. Since its debut in 2016, ZooMonitor has seen more than 1,600 registrations from 78 countries and is cited in more than 100 publications.

ALL TOGETHER NOW

Lincoln Park Zoo is constantly improving ZooMonitor. A recently added community feature allows institutions to collaborate with one another. It has led to the publication of several journal articles evaluating the feeding behavior and habits of giraffes living at 18 AZA-accredited institutions—the largest studies of their kind. Earlier this year, the zoo announced that ZooMonitor would now be free for any organization to use. More than 1,600 zoos and sanctuaries in 78 countries have registered to use this Lincoln Park Zoo-created app. Previously, it had been offered for free to accredited institutions, but now any organization around the world with animals in their care can benefit from this robust, standardized tool



ADVANCING CHIMPANZEE WELFARE

Zoo scientists unveiled the ChimpCARE Tool in 2024 to help organizations evaluate chimpanzee care and make recommendations to improve welfare through objective measurements and up-to-date science. Designed over five years with help from the zoo and sanctuary community, the ChimpCARE Tool assesses nutrition, enrichment, habitats, social structures, and safety. In its first year, the web-based resource was accessed by 164 users from around the world. In 2024, zoo experts traveled to Chimfunshi Wildlife Orphanage Trust in Chingola, Zambia. There they met with keepers from seven African countries, along with the U.S. and France, to exchange ideas and provide training on the tool.

Conserving Wildlife, Nature, and Communities

Lincoln Park Zoo is committed to saving species wherever they live, and our researchers are making an impact from the forests and savannas of Africa to the streets of Chicago.

THE IMPACT OF KOPELION

Lincoln Park Zoo's reach extends far beyond the borders of Chicago, thanks to partners like KopeLion. Recent studies conducted in the Ngorongoro Conservation Area in Tanzania, co-authored by zoo scientists and the KopeLion team, are highlighting how African lions adapt to survive in shared landscapes. Their research also confirms that conservation efforts to promote coexistence between humans and lions are having a positive impact on the long-term chances of these wild cats. The leadership of Ilchokuti-Maasai "lion guardians"-is helping to make travel into and out of the Ngorongoro Crater easier and safer for lions, helping them find mates with a range of genetic traits and contributing to the health of the species.

URBAN WILDLIFE AROUND THE WORLD

Through biodiversity monitoring and community partnerships, the zoo's Urban Wildlife Institute collects data designed to help people and animals coexist in modern cities. UWI collaborates with universities, research labs, and nongovernmental institutions as part of the zoo's Urban Wildlife Information Network, which in 2024 expanded to 60 partners in 10 countries on four continents. In the last year, UWIN welcomed new collaborators from Campobasso, Italy; Bushbrickridge, South Africa; Savannah, Georgia; and San Diego, California. In September 2025, UWIN partners convened at Lincoln Park Zoo for the Connectivity in Conservation symposium.



EXPANSION IN SOUTH AMERICA

The more UWIN partners the zoo recruits around the globe, the clearer the picture of urban wildlife becomes. Recent additions to the network, like Brazil, Argentina, Costa Rica, and Mexico-countries with high levels of biodiversity—are critical to deepening our understanding of the prevalence and diversity of urbandwelling species. In 2024, Lincoln Park Zoo scientists offered workshops to UWIN partner Ecotono Laboratory in Bariloche, Argentina, helping them with analysis and field work techniques and developing opportunities for multicity collaboration.

CITY CONNECTIONS

Urban wildlife species may differ around the world, but many of the challenges to human-animal coexistence remain similar. Urban Wildlife Institute scientists are working to better understand the relationship between city development and ecosystems through programs like the Chicago Rat Project, focusing on conflict and public health risks, and the Chicago Garden Wildlife Project, designed to beautify and benefit neighborhoods by helping local gardeners attract the wildlife they want while avoiding the animals they don't.

Lincoln Park Zoo's urban wildlife initiatives represent the largest and longest-running study of urban wildlife in the world.







2024 URBAN WILDLIFE HIGHLIGHTS


- A UWI multiyear study discovered that gentrified parts of a city have more species diversity—a finding that has implications for the accessibility of restorative natural surroundings to marginalized communities in cities.
- The Bat Tracker program, which monitors bat activity in Chicago, expanded its scope to increase sampling, track bat population trends, and learn more about habitat that can best support the eight species of bats that live in the region.
- A North American river otter was spotted on local motion-activated wildlife cameras for the first time by UWI scientists. Otters returning to the region is a promising sign that area ecosystems are providing safe spaces for wildlife.
- In fall 2024, keeper Brittany Childs traveled to the Pacific Northwest through an opportunity provided by the Feay Field Research Travel Fund Grant to learn about beaver management and participate in field work that helps foster coexistence between humans and these industrious rodents.
- Beavers have again been spotted at the zoo's Nature Boardwalk!

Urbs in Horto

The City of Chicago's motto is *urbs in horto*, which translates to "city in a garden." Lincoln Park Zoo is a garden in the heart of the city.



HORTICULTURE HONORS

In 2024, Lincoln Park Zoo received Level III accreditation from the ArbNet Arboretum Accreditation Program. The zoo was also accredited as a botanic garden by Botanic Gardens Conservation International, a designation that recognizes the zoo's commitment to plant conservation and sustainability. Both accreditations are pioneering achievements for the zoo's science-based Horticulture program, which offers world-class care for many gardens and more than 655 plant species on the zoo's 49-acre campus.

THE ZOO BLOOMS

In 2024, the zoo introduced What's In Bloom, a cart stationed near Searle Visitor Center to help guests discover which flowers are at peak bloom throughout the year.

Each July and August, the zoo grounds become gloriously dramatic and colorful thanks to the country's only accredited perennial herbaceous hibiscus collection.

Last fall, the Horticulture team planted a tree sapling from the cuttings of the storied bur oak that—until April 2023—presided for 170 years on the South Lawn. The legacy tree now stands near the original bur oak site and is expected to grow 8–12 inches annually.

BOARDWALK BUSINESS

The greenery at Lincoln Park Zoo includes around 400 species of native, invasive, and ornamental plants across the 14 acres of Nature Boardwalk. A recent Floristic Quality Assessment documented the fact that 78% of species in this prairie ecosystem are native. This is good news, as it indicates that species richness is increasing as a result of thoughtful management by zoo staff. In 2024, the Horticulture department began using controlled prairie burns as a way of naturally managing the renewal process for the grassland ecosystem.

GARDENS FOR ANIMALS

Zoo guests, human and pollinator alike, can benefit from Lincoln Park Zoo's lush foliage. Zoo animals also benefit from the expertise of zoo horticulturists.

At Regenstein African Journey, live ficus trees throughout the building—including Alii fig and fiddle leaf fig trees—provide "browse," or natural plant materials, for zoo residents. Browse gardens throughout the zoo produce woody and leafy nutrition, an important part of animal diets during the growing season. Staff at Regenstein Center for African Apes also tend an herb and flower garden for the chimpanzees and western lowland gorillas (pictured right).

Lincoln Park Zoo continues to innovate in the field of accessibility, offering new programs, listening to communities, and making sure the zoo is a place where everyone can learn, enjoy, and connect with nature.



VITAL SIGNS

Lincoln Park Zoo recently finished the installation of inclusive signage to help every guest engage in the full zoo experience. Three animal signs, designed with the input of people with disabilities, feature tactile elements, video, and auditory descriptions that can be used by anyone with special needs. Guests can interact with a harbor seal sign at Kovler Seal Pool, a giraffe sign at Regenstein African Journey, and a western lowland gorilla sign at Regenstein Center for African Apes.



ACCESSIBILITY MATTERS

The zoo continues to showcase why it was honored by the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts for its accessibility work. In 2024, zoo educators completed the first year of the Sharing Wellness and Nature program, which gave people living with dementia and their care partners close-up access to animal care. The program included enrichment sessions with meerkats and a bug toss to feathered friends in McCormick Bird House.

In 2024, the zoo once again hosted two special events. DreamNight was an evening specifically curated for children with chronic or terminal illnesses and their families. Chicago HOPES for Kids provided families from homeless and domestic violence shelters across the city with a safe, private evening at the zoo.

At Spring Egg-Stravaganza, a beeping egg hunt option provided a fun alternative for guests who are blind or have low vision (pictured below). Throughout the summer, American Sign Language interpreters at animal chats ensured that guest engagement programs were more accessible to visitors. The zoo also partnered with the Chicago Hearing Society to create ASL names for giraffes Finely and Rae.

Artecito, the co-created program between OPEN and Lincoln Park Zoo, continues to provide free, bilingual, nature-inspired workshops.




BACKLOT COFFEE






DIANE P. BEEMER

Diane's kindness, compassion, and generous spirit continue to inspire all who knew her.



JOE DOHERTY

Joe Doherty and his wife, Gretchen Hoffmann, have supported Lincoln Park Zoo with generosity and dedication for 45 years. Joe earned degrees from Franklin and Marshall College and Harvard University before embarking on a distinguished career in finance that carried him from Chicago to Basel, Switzerland, and on to London. 


REMEMBERING ROXY PEPPER
